Federal Assembly

- **♦** National Council
- Council of District

National Council

- √ 100 Members
- ✓ Citizens vote for 100 members every 4 years

Council of District

- ✓ 23 Members
- ✓ Represents the 23 districts
- ✓ Citizens vote for every 2 years

Both Assemblies

- ✓ Both chambers of parliament undertake legislative duties
- ✓ Citizens may attend sessions in parliament
- ✓ All citizens can challenge any law or amendments proposed by the Federal Assembly

Also...

- If the assembly decides to add or revise anything to the constitution, it MUST be put before the people in a ballot. To pass, it requires a double majority—meaning the majority of the citizens must vote for it and a majority of the districts must vote for it.
- Citizen may request an optional vote to contest a new or revised law. To do so they must gather 10,000 signatures within 100 days. If the ballot goes through, the new law is passed or rejected by a simple majority.

- 4 People elected by the Federal Assembly
- Each member leads 2 federal departments

The Representative President

- ✓ Largely ceremonial role
- ✓ Rotates among the members every year
- ✓ Represents the city in international conferences
- ✓ Sets agendas to be discussed at weekly conferences
- ✓ Addresses the citizens on national holidays

Fun Fact

The President does not have more power than the other 3 members in the Federal Council
